Online course	Streaming	Check with Multimedia Services staff for licensing or copyright restrictions.

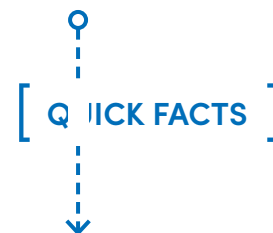
## Video Recording Studios & Media Editing Stations

Two video recording studios equipped with camcorder, lights, computer, projector, and green screen, together with four media editing stations with audio and video editing software, are located on the third floor of Silverman Library. Use the studios and editing stations to:

- Rehearse for class presentations, recitals, mock interviews, or patient interactions
- Create videos for online instruction or micro-modules for your flipped classroom
- Create ePortfolio materials or video essays

### Getting Started

- To use the studios or editing workstations, you'll need to make a reservation. Go to: [library.buffalo.edu/video-recording-studios](http://library.buffalo.edu/video-recording-studios)
- Check the Video Recording Studios and Editing Stations web pages for booking instructions, policies, and a complete list of software available. One workstation has the full Adobe Creative Cloud suite with Premiere Pro and After Effects for advanced composition and editing.
- You'll also need a flash drive with at least 2GB of free space. Please note: portable hard drives cannot be used in the video recording studios.
